## Day Hunt

Guests staying on the main Chatham Island can still take the opportunity to hunt Pitt Island Wild sheep on Pitt Island if time does not permit a longer stay. Guests would need to make their own way to Chathams airport for an 8.30am departure to Pitt Island. The 25min scenic flight by Cessna 206 is a great way to start the day. On arrival at Pitt Island you would be met by your guide. Quad bikes provide easy transport to the hunting areas. All necessary equipment and lunch is provided including firearms if required. The day is spent scoping the rugged back coast of the Island for that perfect trophy with the aim of having you and your trophy back at the airstrip for the flight back to the main Island by 4.30pm.
